WINTER PARKING BAN: 2011-2012

In accordance with the Town of Millis by-laws, Article VII Police Regulations, Section 35 Overnight Street Parking, a ban on overnight parking shall be in effect **from 9:00 p.m. until 6:00 a.m. starting on November 15th and continuing through April 15th. This ban is not limited to snowy or icy conditions.**

During those times, the Police Department of the Town shall have the authority to remove, or cause to be removed, to some convenient place, including in such terms a public garage, any vehicle interfering with the work of the Department of Public Works in removing or plowing of snow or in the removing of ice from the ways of the Town. Fines for violating this by-law are \$25 – first offense, \$25 – second offense, \$50 – each subsequent offense. In addition, if it is snowing or there are icing conditions other than the hours on the overnight parking by-law and a vehicle is parked in the street, it could be ticketed for impeding snow removal.
