1. Fill out form completely
2. Attach check, payable to Town of Millis
3. Submit testing site plan or sketch in accordance to Subsurface Sewage Disposal System Regulation 3.D (see below) depicting the area of proposed testing and nearby environmental resources.

### **Subsurface Sewage Disposal System Regulation 3.D**

**3.D The applicant must submit a proposed testing site plan showing shaded areas of possible soil test locations, any and all wetlands within 100 feet, watercourses within 200 feet and all wells within 125 feet of any part of the potential septic system site with the soil test application. Any and all wetlands locations shall be approved by the Millis Conservation Commission, (by the method they deem appropriate), prior to Board of Health testing. Those lots that do not exhibit any wetlands with two hundred feet of proposed soil testing, must include a certifying statement on the proposed percolation site plan that states, "There are no wetlands located within 200 feet of the testing site as shown", and shall be stamped, signed, and dated with the original stamp and signature of the engineer or sanitarian of record. Within thirty (30) days after soil test having been attempted or completed, the DEP Soils Evaluation Forms and a plot plan (in scale) shall be submitted to the Board of Health showing exact locations of these soil tests. The plan shall include failing as well as passing deep hole and percolation test sites.**

**All expenses shall be borne by the applicant.**
