Submissions For 1ST Ever Millis Film Festival Now Open!

Millis, MA – The Millis Cultural Council is pleased to announce that the call for submissions are now open for narrative, documentary or animated films. Come be a part of something new and become qualifying entry in the first ever Millis Film Festival.

Each of the films for narrative, documentary and animation will have a student and adult and student level award; there will be a separate general category for Middle School entries.

Qualifying films will be announced by the end of January; all qualifying films may be screened at the Festival, to be held on March 1, 2014. The location of the film screenings and festival will be held at a location in Millis.

The submissions deadline is January 15, 2014.

The Millis Film Festival will feature an audience award, and also a juried prize for documentary and narrative feature films. The Juried Prize will carry a cash prize to be determined.
