Route 115 to Boardman Street (traveling from the north bear right on Boardman from the south bear left) then take the next right onto Medway Branch.

The Transfer Station is on the right at the end of Medway Branch.

Waste Limit: You may bring no more than 25 pounds or 10 (1-gallon) containers of listed hazardous waste materials unless specifically approved by Norfolk's Community Coordinator. Please see the back of this form for a list of acceptable household items, or call the DPW Office at 508-528-4990.

The Recycling/Transfer Station reserves the right to refuse any waste deemed unsafe to handle or unsuitable for the collection. Such waste includes:

- Large quantities of unknown materials
- Radioactive waste, including smoke detectors
- Explosives, gun powder, flares, ammunition
- Unsuitable waste
- Pressurized fire extinguishers
- Unknown gas cylinders
- Substances regulated by the Drug Enforcement Agency
- Medical waste

Items accepted for an additional charge:

- Propane tanks \$ 5.00 each
- Units with freon \$ 15.00 each
- Microwave Ovens \$ 5.00 each
- E-Waste \$ 0.31 per pound

Due to the decline in the precious metals market, E-Waste disposal has increased to \$0.31/pound
